#### **Port Saint Lucie Express**

Palm Tran is continuing to prepare for the launch of the Port St. Lucie Express. This new bus service, fully funded by the FDOT, will travel four times daily during peak hours between Port St. Lucie and West Palm Beach for \$2.65 each way. The launch of the service is anticipated for the spring of 2024 pending approval from the PBC Board of County Commissioners.

#### **Intermodal Transit Center Restroom Improvement**

Mr. Forbes was happy to announce that there has been an improvement in the conditions of the restrooms at the Intermodal. Palm Tran has been working with a new vendor to improve the facility and provide a cleaner and more enjoyable experience for our customers.

#### **Emergency Operations Center Supervisor Tour**

Hurricane season is in full swing and we like being prepared. In July, Palm Tran operations supervisors toured the Palm Beach County Emergency Operations Center. The behind-the-scenes tour provided a new perspective on their role in countywide emergency operations.

#### **PRSA Sunshine Radiance Awards**

Mr. Forbes congratulated the Public Relations section on winning five commendations for excellent public relations campaigns and tactics at the Public Relations Society of America Sunshine Radiance Awards. 
### **Back to School Safety**
